### Letter from the Preacher Man - Red Ropes and Yellow Tape

Have you ever been to a black tie event? The kind that only those who are on the guest list is invited to walk into the entrance lined by red velvet ropes. Everyone has on some form of designer attire from tailored suits to flowing gowns and everyone that graces the elegant hall makes a statement of confidence and prestige. Before the day arrives when those who will attend begin to gather there are always preparations made. The gown wasn't chosen thirty minutes before she shows up, the shirt wasn't monogrammed a day early, no someone meticulously paid attention to detail so that when their feet stepped out of the vehicle at this exclusive event everything was ready. There was never one thing left to chance. Hours and hours are invested in the smallest of issues, colors had to match, creases had to be sharp,

hair had to be just right and yes the shoes had to shine so they represent a mirror. If accomplishments got your name on the list, there can be no possible way the attire could show less preparation than your actions and abilities that got you there in the first place.

Have you ever been to a crime scene? The kind that only those with the proper credentials could lift the yellow tape and enter. Laying on the pavement or in their bath tub or on the floor of their home is the remains of one who chose to make one final decision that ended their days walking among us. 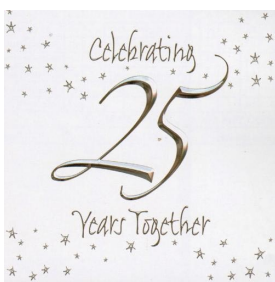
